

ABSENTEE VOTING

Absentee voting begins 40 days prior to each election. For the convenience of Converse County voters, the Clerk's Office has an absentee polling place located at the County Clerk's Office at 107 North 5th St, Ste 114, Douglas, WY. The polling place is open from 8:00a.m. until 5:00 p.m. Monday through Friday for the 40-day period prior to the election.

Registered voters may apply for an absentee ballot by one of the following ways:

By Mail -You can print the application form from this website. Complete the form and mail it to the Converse County Clerk's Office.

By Telephone - You may call the County Clerk's Office at (307) 358-2244.

In Person -Complete the absentee ballot request form and bring into the County Clerk's Office located at the Courthouse, **107 North 5th Street, Suite 114, Douglas, WY 82633**. We are open 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Friday. Once you turn in the completed ballot request form, you are then eligible to receive a ballot. You may cast your ballot at the courthouse or take it with you.

Military Absentee Request – (*Availability to Military ONLY*) Registration through the Federal Postcard Application (FPCA). If you are in the military or an overseas civilian and wish to complete a Federal Post Card Application for temporary registration and voting please go to the Federal Voting Assistance Program <http://www.fvap.gov/index.html>. ALL ABSENTEE BALLOTS MUST BE RECEIVED IN THE COUNTY CLERK'S OFFICE IN DOUGLAS BY 7:00 P.M. ON ELECTION DAY IN ORDER TO BE COUNTED. ABSENTEE BALLOTS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED AT ANY POLLING PLACE.
