

Public Hearing Notice

Community Development Block Grant (CDBG)

The Board of Commissioners, Converse County, WY, will hold a public hearing for funding for the 2011 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program available from the Wyoming Business Council. The public hearing will be held on February 2, 2011 at 1:30 p.m. in the Commissioners' Boardroom. 107 N 5th St., Douglas, WY.

The purpose of the public hearing is to solicit public view, comments, and recommendations for potential sponsorship of grant applications for the CDBG Program.

The Wyoming Business Council will accept applications until March 1, 2011 at 5:00 p.m. The WBC expects to have approximately \$490,000 available for Planning and Technical Assistance; \$1,790,500 for community development, housing infrastructure and group facilities; \$824,500 for economic development; and, \$40,000 for homeownership assistance within the State of Wyoming, with each category having a maximum award.

Interested persons are invited to attend, participate in the process, comment on the program(s), and present potential applications seeking support. Comments may be submitted in writing prior to the meeting. Send comments to Commissioners, 107 N. 5th St., Suite 114, Douglas, WY 82633-2448.
