These rules apply to hearings of appeals or contested cases before the County Board of Equalization and are adopted pursuant to the authority of Wyo. Stat. §39-13-102 and 39-13-103 and in accordance with the procedures set forth in Wyo. Stat. §16-3-103. These rules replace and supersede any rules which may have been adopted previously. These rules meet minimum substantive state statutory requirements.
