

ELECTION JUDGE APPLICATION FOR CONVERSE COUNTY

Converse County depends on good citizens who volunteer to work as Election Judges.

Judges need to be registered voters and must be physically, morally and mentally competent to perform the duties of an election judge. Judges have the responsibility of ensuring that the election process is conducted fairly and efficiently. Judges must be strictly impartial. On Election Day, each precinct needs from 3-5 judges to assist voters.

Judges are obligated to attend at least one election school training. Converse County pays \$25.00 for training and on Election Day \$150.00. Election judge's work begins **promptly** at 6:00 a.m. and usually ends around 8 p.m. on Election Day.

I understand that this does not guarantee that I will be appointed. If I am appointed, it may be for an Election Judge, Alternate Election Judge, Registration Judge, or Counting Board Judge. I would be willing to serve as a judge in any of these areas.
