Converse County Approach Access Permits

Effective 8/15/2011 approach access permits will be processed and approved by the Converse County Road & Bridge department. The assignment of rural addresses (outside of city limits) within Converse County will be done through the Converse County Assessor's office only after the Road and Bridge foreman has approved the approach.

Applications for approach access and/or address permits are available at the Converse County Road & Bridge office located at 10 Twin Bridges Road in Douglas as well as online at <http://conversecounty.org>. A new approach access requires a fee of \$50.00 plus \$0.50 cents per mile x 2 round trips from the Douglas Road & Bridge office, which must accompany the completed application. All new accesses off of county roads must be approved by the Converse County Road and Bridge. There is five (5) day processing of new accesses to allow for the inspection by the Road and Bridge (weather permitting).

Upon approval of the access, an address may be assigned (if requested by applicant) based on the counties' rural addressing policy. *All rural addresses must be approved by the Assessor's office in order for the United States Postal Service to deliver mail.* A confirmation of address will be given with each address request and that confirmation will satisfy the USPO requirements.
