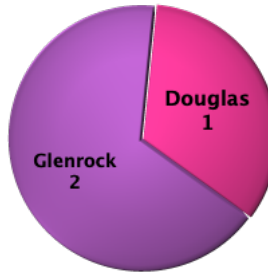
POSITIVES

An individual has tested positive.



PROBABLES

An individual is deemed to be a probable case when they have a known exposure to someone that tested positive for COVID and are symptomatic.



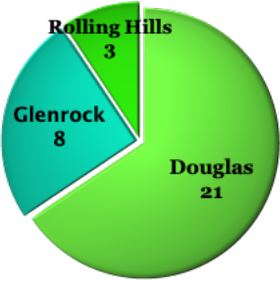
QUARANTINE

An individual is deemed to be in quarantine when they have a known exposure but have not developed any symptoms.



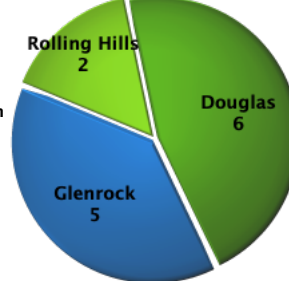
RECOVERED POSITIVES

Deemed recovered when individual has not had a fever for 24 hours, improved respiratory symptoms, & it has been 7 days since symptom onset.



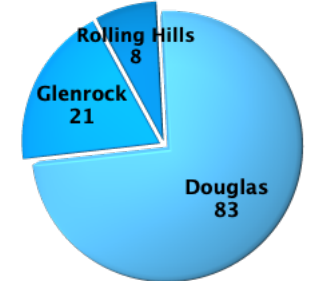
RECOVERED PROBABLES

An individual that had known exposure, and symptoms and has recovered.

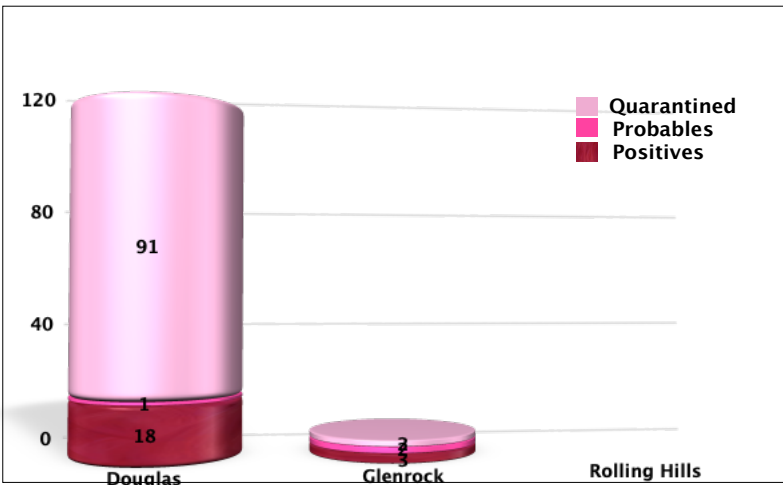


RELEASED FROM QUARANTINE

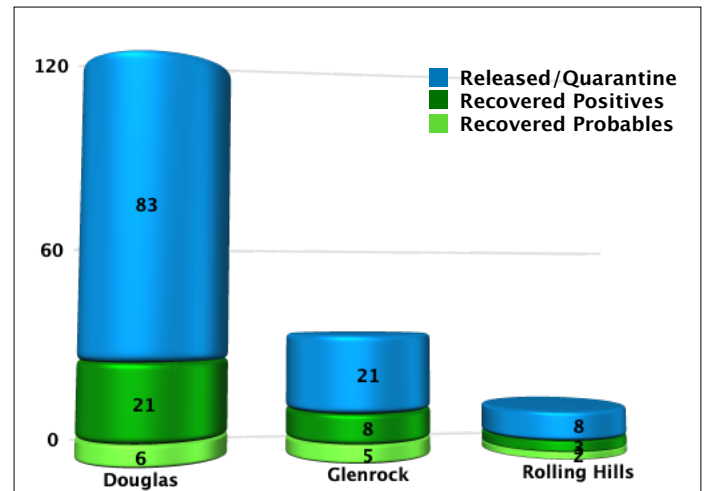
Individual that has completed 14 day quarantine AND never exhibited symptoms.



Totals by Area

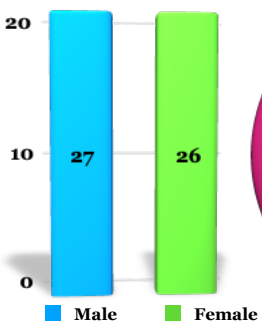


Recovered by Area

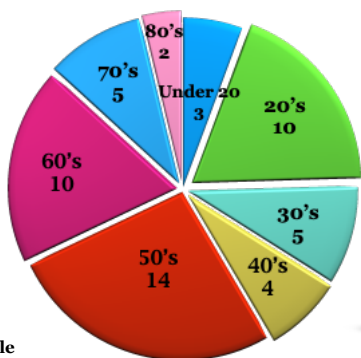

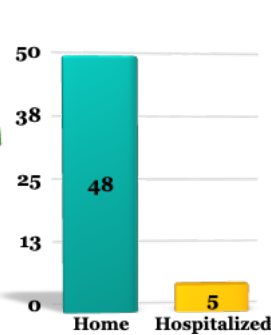

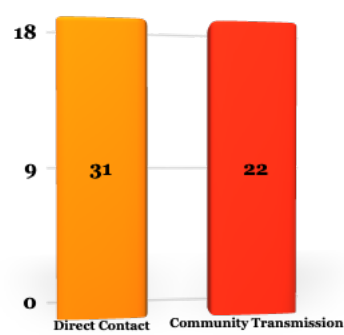

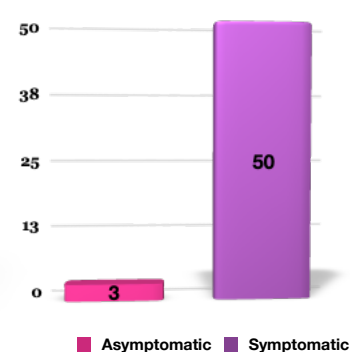
